

Angola Customs Reporting mandatory requirements for Air Cargo, effective 1 June 2018

What is this all about?

Angola Customs have announced the implementation of electronic Advance Cargo Information (ACI) requirements using IATA Cargo-XML standards, mandatory as of 1 June 2018. Carriers are responsible for filing Import, Transit and FROB Cargo information in advance of the flight arrival at destination, for short haul flights and long haul flights. The source data are Master Air Waybill (MAWB), House Air Waybill (HAWB), and flight manifest information.

How can CHAMP help?

CHAMP is offering a filing service that is compliant with Angola Customs' mandatory requirements via its Traxon Global Customs (TGC) service



How does TGC work?

Carriers only need to send their IATA Cargo-IMP FWB, FHL, FFM messages to the CHAMP TGC service on flight departure and TGC takes care of the rest – connecting to Customs, and filing the correct customs messages on time using the Cargo-IMP message data supplied by the carrier. You will need to provide flight schedule information to CHAMP, which is part of the TGC solution offering.
