Are you able to sponsor visas?

At the moment we are unable to offer sponsorship or visas.

Where are you and your roles based?

We are based at St. Mary's Axe, Liverpool Street, London. From a delivery perspective we are customer dependent but are EMEA focussed.

What's your stance on remote working?

We are dependent on customer requirements but offer a mature and flexible environment.

Can I reapply if previously unsuccessful?

Do you hire graduates?

At the moment we don't have opportunities in delivery for graduates however this may change in the future.

What Right To Work documents will I need?

Right to Work documents are required from all new starters to provide evidence of their entitlement to work in the UK. These documents will be checked and authorised by our Office Manager previous to their first day, failure to provide satisfactory evidence of your right to work in the UK will prevent an application progressing.

It is Mesh-AI's legal obligation to ensure that anyone we are looking to employ is legally entitled to work in the UK before their employment begins.
