
Traxon Global Customs (TGC) has extended its reach to 3 new countries, bringing that number to 50+ covered around the world that require Advance Electronic Information compliance. As of September, TGC will cover Jamaica, Russia, and the Maldives, and offer advance filling to these countries according to new customs requirements.

TGC is not only an interactive and easy-to-use customs solution, but also an all-in-one platform that eliminates the need for multiple advance filing solutions. It helps reduce costs and complexity via a single interface. With its smart features of proactive reporting and alert functionality the client can always be one step ahead of related problems and avoid customs fines.

Jamaica has required IATA CargoXML for compliance messaging. Carriers only need to send their IATA Cargo-IMP FWB, FHL, FFM, and MVT messages to the TGC service on flight departure prior to arrivals to and from Jamaica territory and TGC takes care of the rest to adapt the message format and file the correct message to Customs.

Russia is the second Eurasian Union country offered by TGC. This fully automated solution has been updated from a semi-automated one previously offered. The next Eurasian Union countries planned for rollout include; Armenia, Belarus, and Kazakhstan.

The Maldives have similarly asked the airline community to electronically file its cargo data in advance for all import and transit shipments. Via Traxon Global Customs, customers can ensure that such requirements are fulfilled on time.
